The Fatima Peace Pilgrimage is sponsored by the Te Deum Foundation.

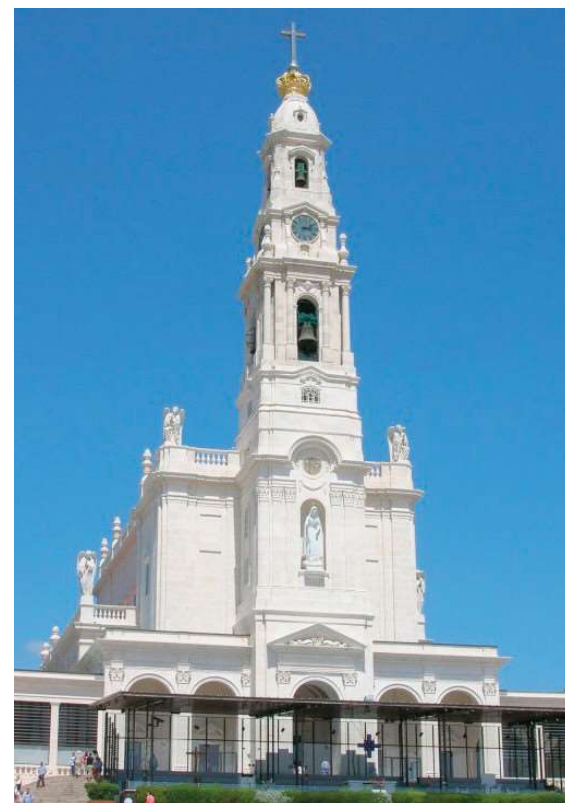

2023 ITINERARY



Friday, July 28th

Today we journey to Tomar, going back to the days of Medieval Knights, to the fortress and convent of the Knights of Templar which was later used by the Order of Christ. Return to Fatima for lunch and in the evening we enjoy a very special dinner at a local village restaurant.

Saturday, July 29th

Today we will travel to Lisbon, the Capital of Portugal. Mass at the birthplace of St.

Anthony. Visit the 12th Century Cathedral where the Saint was baptized. Visit St. Jerome's Monastery, an outstanding example of Portuguese architecture. After a picnic lunch in the park, we will visit Obidos, a fortified medieval city that was a Moorish stronghold before the 10th Century. In 1148, it was freed by Portugal's first king and in 1228, it was given to Queen Isabella by her husband, King Denis. Future monarch repeated this gesture to their consorts.

Dinner at Fatima at Domus Pacis.

Wednesday, July 19th

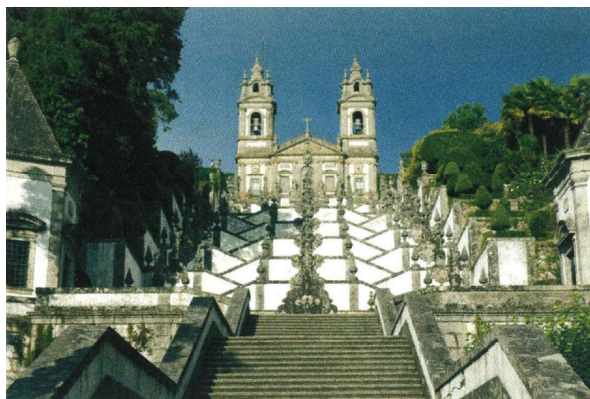
Board United Airlines for overnight flight to Lisbon.

Thursday, July 20th

Arrive in Lisbon. After clearing customs, board motorcoach to Fatima. Arrival at Domus Pacis for lunch and check-in. After lunch, we will visit the Shrine, including the Basilica, where Jacinta, Francisco and Sister Lucia are buried, the Chapel of the Apparitions (Capelinha). Participate in the Rosary and candlelight procession.

Friday, July 21st

After breakfast, visit Aljustrel, the hamlet of the children and see their homes. Also visit the Loco de Cabeco, where the Angel gave communion to the children; Valinhos, where Our Lady appeared in August of 1917 after the children were released from prison. Have Mass at the Fatima Parish Church where they were baptized. After lunch, time for personal activities. After dinner, participate in the Rosary and candlelight procession.



Saturday, July 22nd

Tour of Coimbra: one of the loveliest areas of Portugal, extremely important from a cultural and historical standpoint. We will visit the 17th Century Church of Santa Clara to see the tomb of Queen Saint Isabella of Portugal. Then, we will visit the Holy Cross Church, with the Manueline tombs of the first kings of Portugal, and a lovely sacristy with the statue of St. Anthony who started his studies here as an Augustinian monk. We will also visit the Carmelite Convent where Sister Lucia was a cloistered nun and see her personal memorabilia. Return to Fatima for dinner.

Sunday, July 23rd

You may wish to participate in the Shrine activities. Mass is at 11:00 at the Basilica. After lunch, the remainder of the day will be on your own. There will be the Solemn Eucharistic Procession in the late afternoon at the Basilica.

Monday, July 24th

We will have a day in Fatima for devotions and other activities. We will also participate in the Hungarian Stations of the Cross.

Tuesday, July 25th

We begin our journey toward northern Portugal and will arrive in Balazar for Holy Mass. Visit the home of Blessed Alexandrina where we will hear about her inspiring life and her love for the Eucharist. We will have our picnic lunch under the orange trees. Traveling northeast, we will arrive in Braga to visit Portugal's National Shrine of the Immaculate Conception on Mount Sameiro and the Shrine of Bom Jesus (Good Jesus) and its magnificent exterior staircase with figures from the Passion of Christ. Return to Fatima for dinner.

Wednesday, July 26th

Today we'll visit Santarem for Mass at the Church of the Eucharistic Miracle and venerate the "Bleeding Host". Lunch in Fatima. In the afternoon we will visit Batalha the Historical Monastery of Santa Maria Victoria. The impressive 14th Century building commemorates the victory of the out-numbered Portuguese army over the Castilians in 1346.

Thursday, July 27th

We will depart for Alcobaca. The name is derived from the confluence of the two rivers: Alcoa and Baca. Location of an old Cistercian Monastery which dominates the charming town: important for agricultural, fruit and wine production. We proceed to the fishing village of Nazare for Holy Mass, a seaside visit and lunch. Return to Fatima for dinner.
